Staff Recommended Motion:

Approve Resolution 20-10(F).

Background:

The CRA's Strategic Finance Plans for the City Center/Downtown CRA District, Amendment No. 14, identifies infrastructure projects located within the Historic Northwest and funded with the Series 2019 Bond.

The City and CRA worked together on the design of the 7th Street Streetscape and Passageway. The design features a curbless street, wider sidewalks and more tree canopy, with a shared passageway to serve as a frontage to the new businesses to be located on 7th Street.

Resolution No. 19-1 approved the issuance of \$110,000,000 in Series 2019 Bonds for the CRA. As part of the bond issuance, the 7th Street Streetscape was allocated \$2,268,000. The Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) was received in December 2019 at \$4,837,433.68. The CRA will allocate the remainder of the GMP from the Evernia/Datura Streetscape project. As part of the Series 2019 bond issuance, funding may include any redevelopment project approved by resolution of the Board in addition to the projects listed in the issuance of the Series 2019 Bonds.
