- Offenders may be removed from the meeting.

RESOLUTION NO. 77-21: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST PALM BEACH, FLORIDA, DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION IN SAID CITY HELD ON MARCH 9, 2021 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING CERTAIN ELECTED OFFICIALS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Approve Resolution No. 77-21.

Background:

A General Election for the purpose of electing City Commissioners for the City of West Palm Beach was held on March 9, 2021, in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City and the laws of the State of Florida governing and regulating the holding of General Elections.

Resolution No. 77-21 declares the results of the March 9, 2021, General Election as follows:

For City Commissioner District 2, the following votes were cast by the qualified electors residing and voting within said City:

- For: Deandre Poole 3,778 42.72%
- For: Shalonda Warren 4,687 53.00%

For City Commissioner District 4, the following votes were cast by the qualified electors residing and voting within said City:

- For: Jonathan Jones 2,708 30.31%
- For: Joe Peduzzi 6,224 69.69%

2. Swearing in ceremony for newly elected City Commissioners for the City of West Palm Beach.

Background:

The swearing in ceremony for the newly elected City Commissioners is being held pursuant to Sec. 2-1, Code of Ordinances, which reads: "Sec. 2-1. - Commencement of terms of office. The term of office of a newly elected Mayor or newly elected City Commissioner shall commence at 5:00 p.m. on the fourth Thursday immediately following the regular election." The oath of office will be administered to the newly elected City Commissioners: Shalonda Warren (District 2) and Joe Peduzzi (District 4).

3. Election of the President of the City Commission.

Background:

The election of the President of the City Commission will take place pursuant to Sec. 2.05 of the City's Charter which reads: "Sec. 2.05. - Induction and meetings. After each annual city election, the newly elected members shall be inducted and assume office at a public meeting. At such meeting, the City Commissioners shall elect one (1) of their number to the office of the President of the City Commission who shall serve at the pleasure of the City Commission."
