Background Information:

Last February 1, 2022, the CRA issue a Request for Proposals ("RFP") accepting proposals from qualified applicants for the operation of the historic Sunset Lounge. The RFP identified the following objectives:

- a) The ultimate objective is the revival of the Sunset Lounge as a state-of-the-art performance and art-focused venue and African American cultural tourism destination that pays homage to its rich jazz history and the black history of the area, which further encourages the economic development of the historic Northwest neighborhood.
- b) Additionally, the CRA desires that the Sunset Lounge operator provide direct community benefits through the offering of music lessons, art exhibitions and performing arts classes, along with training for jobs in the hospitality industry.
- c) The CRA also desires that the operator of the Sunset Lounge provide programming for Heart & Soul park in connection with activities at the Sunset Lounge.

Two (2) proposals were received on May 16, 2022, from Mad Room Hospitality and Vita LLC.

A Technical Review Committee consisting of five members representing the entertainment and business community (Frank Baker, Diane Quinn, Gopal Rajegowda, Alisha Winn and Donald Burgess) reviewed the proposals, provided comments and scored the proposals according to a technical criteria established by the RFP.

In addition, the two proposers participated in a Community Stakeholder Tasting Experience on June 14, 2022 and members of the community were provided the opportunity to score each proposer showcase on decor, entertainment, food and beverage, hospitality and overall experience.

The CRA Board will decide the best value to the City, by tally vote, and will select one Proposer to begin negotiating an Operating Agreement. The CRA Board may require additional information and/or additional presentations prior to selection.

CRA/City staff will negotiate with the Proposer selected by the CRA Board for negotiation of a contract, based on the requirements of the RFP, and as directed by the CRA Board. The negotiated terms will be presented to the CRA Board for approval.
