**Background Information:**  
The CRA strategic finance plan includes as one of its goals the promotion of business development in the Northwest neighborhood. It is with this goal in mind that the CRA intends to dispose of the CRA-owned property located at 800 North Tamarind Avenue. The goal is to attract new businesses along the Tamarind corridor, and in particular the location of a passenger transportation business that provides neighborhood residents with mobility options.

The 800 North Tamarind Avenue property was acquired by the CRA in 2010 for \$30,000 and has remained vacant until now. The redevelopment of this property will advance the redevelopment and business attraction goals of the CRA. This property will accompany several other redevelopment and economic development projects that are also creating commercial activity along Tamarind Avenue. By initiating the disposition of

the property now, the CRA allows a potential project to be constructed in tandem with the Tamarind Avenue streetscape construction.
