

## **SIGN POSTING REQUIREMENTS**

## FOR ALL APPLICATIONS GOING TO THE PLANNING BOARD / CITY COMMISSION

The applicant will be responsible for public notice of the project by posting of the property in accordance with the following:

- Signs shall be provided by the applicant at a size generally at a minimum of four (4) feet in width and four (4) feet in length.
- The sign shall have a white background with black letters. The height of the lettering shall conform to the minimum dimensions indicated below.
- The sign shall contain the City's logo at a minimum height of four (4) inches. The graphic file for the logo can be obtained from the Planning Division and shall be black & white only (no color).
- The property shall be posted by the applicant no further than fifteen (15) feet from the property line, or as specified by the Planning Division based on site constraints.
- Signs shall be posted in a workmanlike manner, able to withstand normal weather events.
- Privately-initiated applications require that at least one (1) sign be posted per 500 lineal feet of all property located along
  a public right-of-way, with a minimum of one (1) sign per frontage, or as otherwise required by the Planning and Zoning
  Administrator.
- Signs shall be posted at least 15 days prior to the first public hearing.
- An affidavit on page 15 of this application, including photographs, attesting to the date of installation and number of signs
  installed shall be provided at least five (5) days prior to the required public hearing.
- The applicant shall remove the posting within thirty (30) days after the final City Commission's decision on the subject application.
