








Grassy Waters Preserve Activity Packet

All About Grassy Waters Preserve!

- Grassy Waters Preserve is a 15,000 acre Everglades habitat, which is the same size as about 11,500 football fields!
- The Everglades is a wetland, meaning the habitat is often covered with water.
- The Preserve is home to many animals, such as alligators, wading birds, frogs, snakes, raccoons, bobcats, and otters.
- Grassy Waters Preserve provides drinking water for the City of West Palm Beach and surrounding communities.


